#### RESOLUTIONS

- 12.1 **Implementation of AICTE model curriculum 2018:** An extensive discussion is needed to study the AICTE Model Curriculum, 2018. As the time available is too short for a detailed study, it is decided to implement new curriculum from the academic year 2019-2020.
- Internship to IV B.Tech. Students: The academic council has approved to introduce Internships for IV B. Tech. II Semester students at Foreign Universities/ Industry/ Research Laboratories based on the recommendations of the committee constituted at department level and ratified by the Principal. The student can utilize the Internship for the whole semester provided that the student has to appear for End Semester examinations along with his/her batch. Mid examinations will be conducted for them through online mode.
- 12.3 Grace marks for change of grade: The academic council has approved to add 0.15% Grace marks for the improvement of class for B. Tech. Courses from First Class to

Distinction, Second class to first class, Pass class to Second class for B. Tech. Courses. A total of 0.15% maximum marks are added to final year Mini Project/Major Project/Term Paper/Seminar.

- 12.4 Grace Marks for failed students: The academic council has approved:
  - i. A maximum of 0.15% adjustment marks shall be added to the latest performance of failed theory subject(s) and limited to a maximum of two failed subjects only.
  - ii. The required marks shall be adjusted from external marks of passed subjects of the final year Project/Seminar/ Theory only, both for UG and PG programmes.
  - iii. The student must have appeared at least one supplementary examination.

The student seeking benefit of 0.15% adjustment marks shall apply through proper channel, enclosing failed original marks memos. The Principal shall verify the eligibility criteria at the college level, i.e., whether the student passes the failed subject (s), if 0.15% adjustment marks facility extended, i.e., 0.15% of grand total marks of UG/PG programmes.

Separate approval shall be obtained case by case independently for the eligible students for implementation of the above relaxation as and when applications are received.

- 12.5 Challenge Valuation: The Academic Council has approved Challenge valuation for UG/PG courses on paying a fee of Rs. 10,000/- for each subject for challenge revaluation. The revaluation will be carried out by a committee nominated by the Principal of the College consisting of three members out of which a Senior Professor from Prasad V Potluri Siddhartha Institute of Technology, a faculty from PVPSIT, and a faculty from outside the college who are well versed with the subject. The student will forfeit the challenging fee if the difference in the marks given by the committee is not more than 15% of the maximum marks compared to the marks already shown in the marks list. If the marks are more than 15%, the challenge fee will be returned to the candidate. After the challenge valuation, if the marks are more than 15% or there is a change in the status of the grade, the new marks will be awarded, otherwise, the previous marks will remain. The application for challenge Revaluation has to be submitted by the student paying the prescribed fee and a copy of Marks Memo.
- 12.6 **Review of Semester results:** The Academic Council has reviewed Semester results of I-I, III-I, III-I, IV-I, 2017-2018.
- 12.7 **Review of faculty contribution:** The Academic Council has reviewed Faculty achievements for the academic year 2017-18.
