










Agenda for BOS meeting on 21-04-2018.

1. To discuss the AICTE model Curriculum for UG programme.

Resolutions:

1. The existing course structure and syllabi for Under Graduate (B.Tech) Program were approved in AY 2014-15, named as PVP14 regulation. Efforts were made to revise the course structure, syllabi and regulation for undergraduate program named as PVP18. In this regard the Board of Studies meeting was conducted on 26th Nov 2017. to review the proposed regulation along with course structure and syllabi and approved to be implemented in AY 2018-19.
2. further, in order to incorporate the suggestions made by AICTE through model curriculum, this BOS meeting was called and members of BOS critically reviewed both PVP18 regulation and AICTE model curriculum. The members of BOS felt that, the syllabus proposed in AICTE model curriculum was somewhat heavy for most of the courses and hence it was suggested that syllabi may be framed in accordance with syllabus of Competitive Exams like CAT, IES, etc.,
3. In view of the above, members of BOS discussed various possibilities and unanimously resolved to defer implementing of PVP-18 in AY 2018-19 and to continue PVP14 regulation for 2018-19. AICTE model curriculum guidelines may be considered for AY 2019-20 after critical review and discussions.
