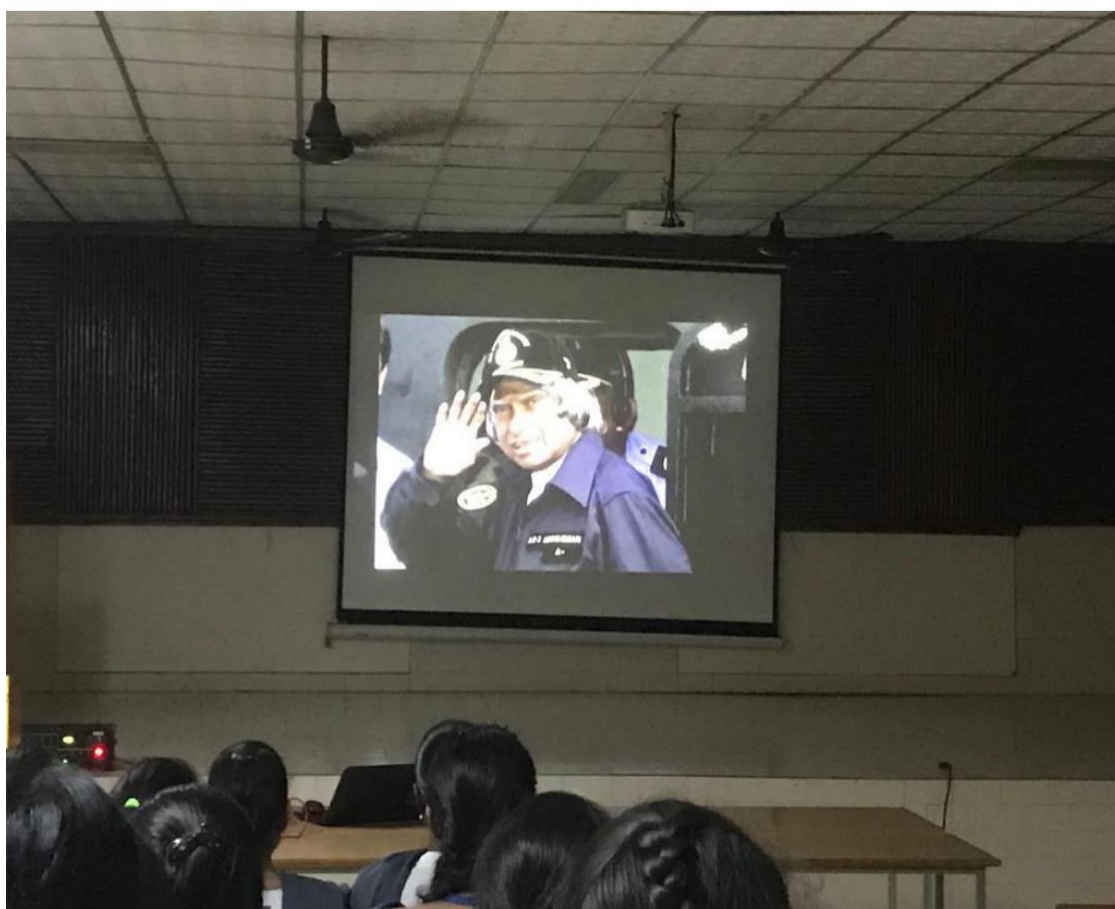
4. PLANTATION PROGRAM

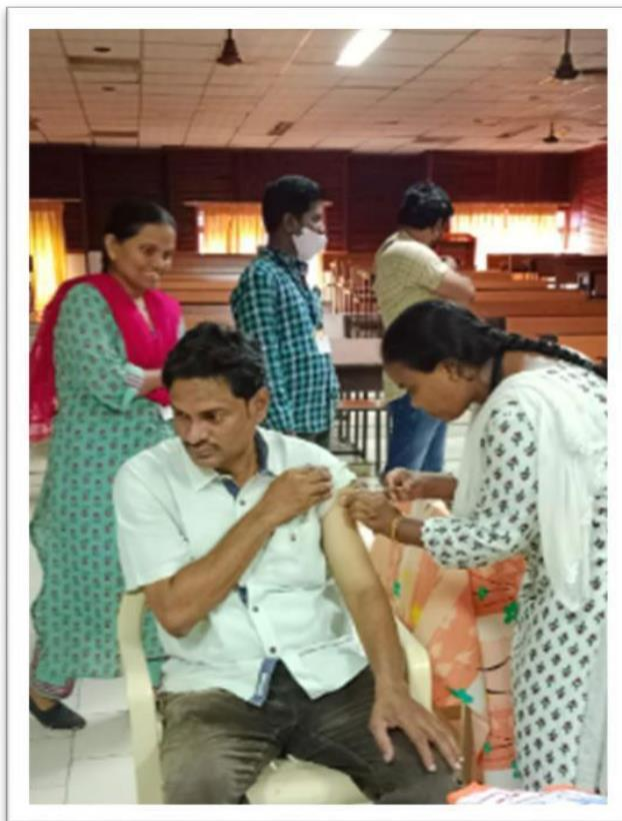
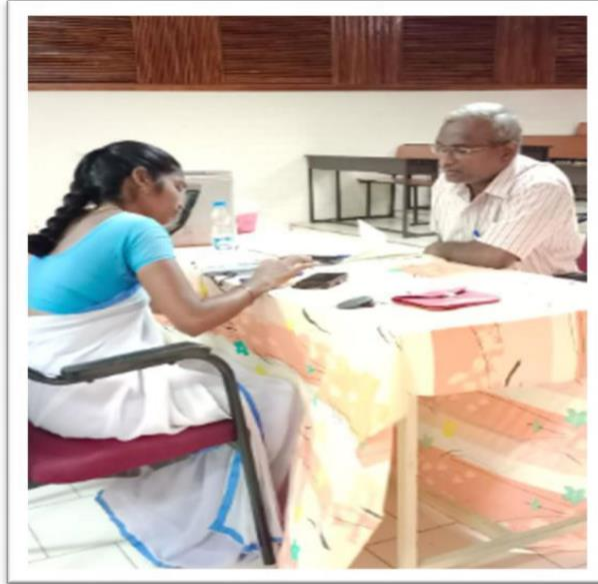
6. GUEST LECTURE ON RETHINK WASTE

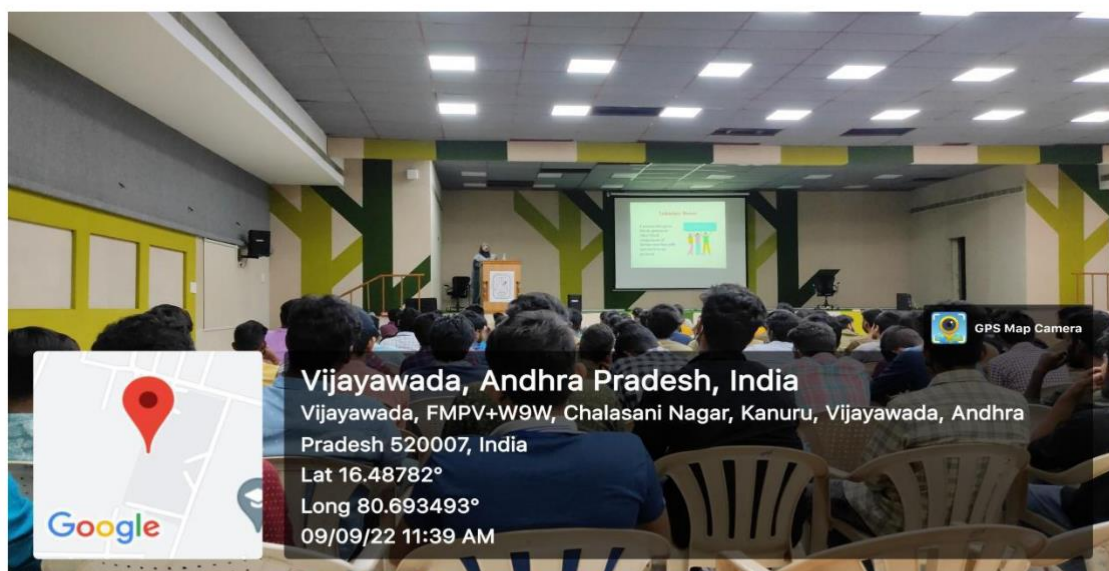
12. HEMOGLOBIN TESTS

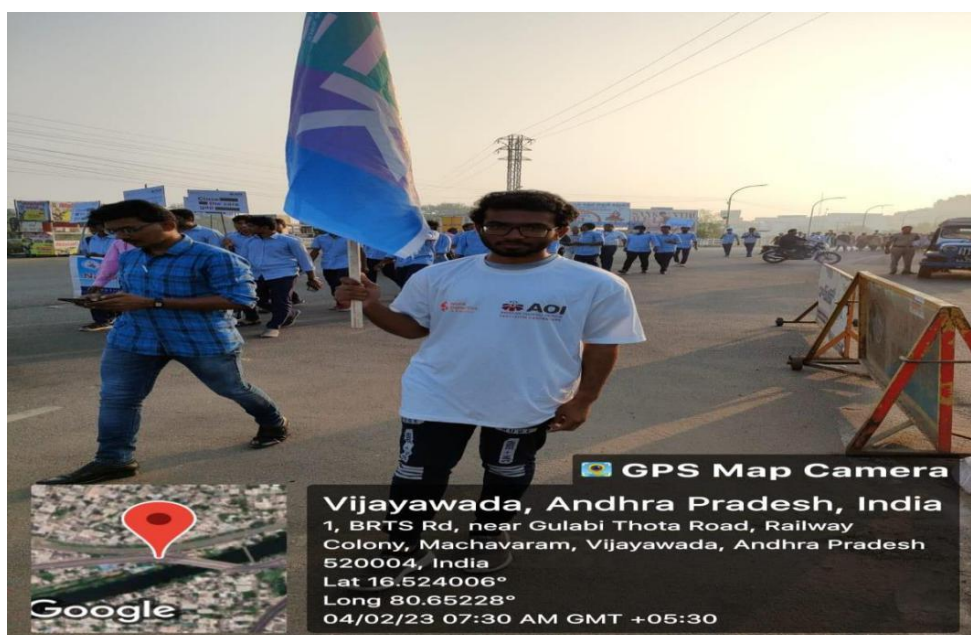
39. NATIONAL VOTERS DAY

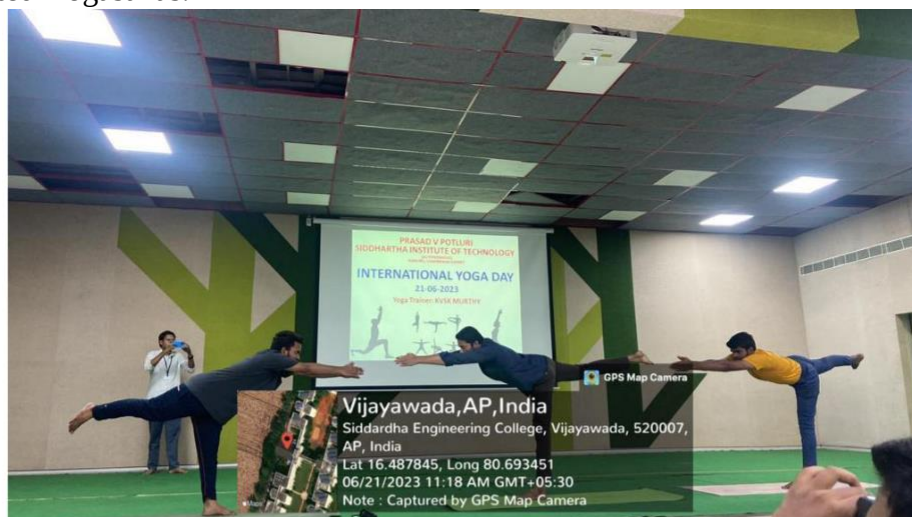
60. SAVE SOIL CAMPAIGN

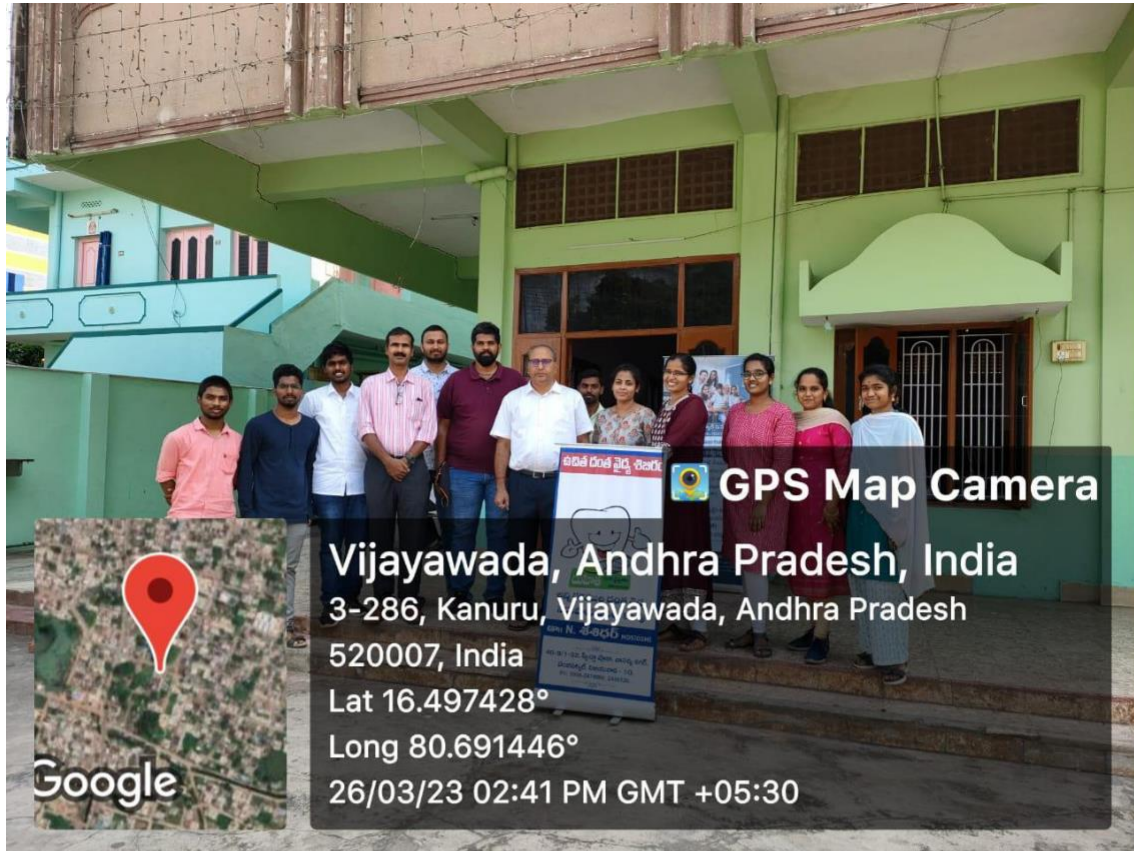

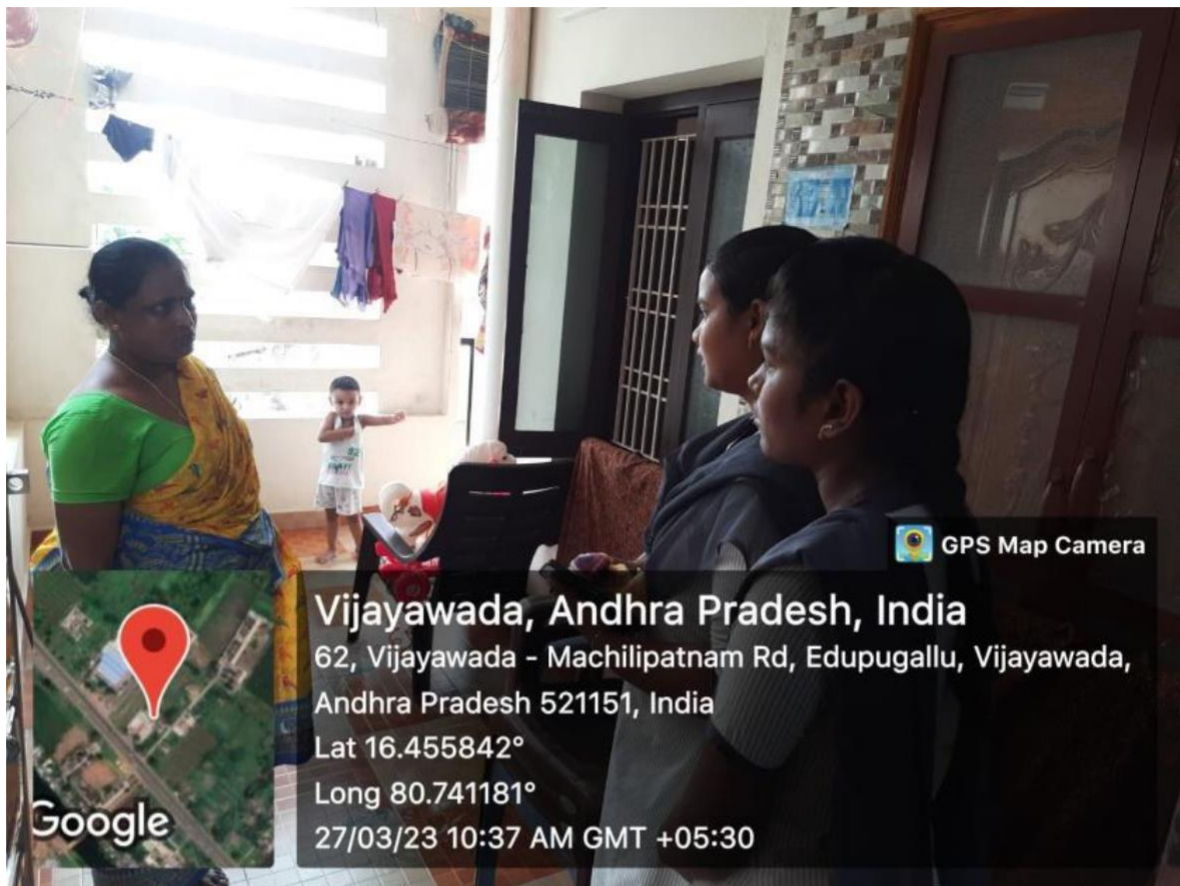

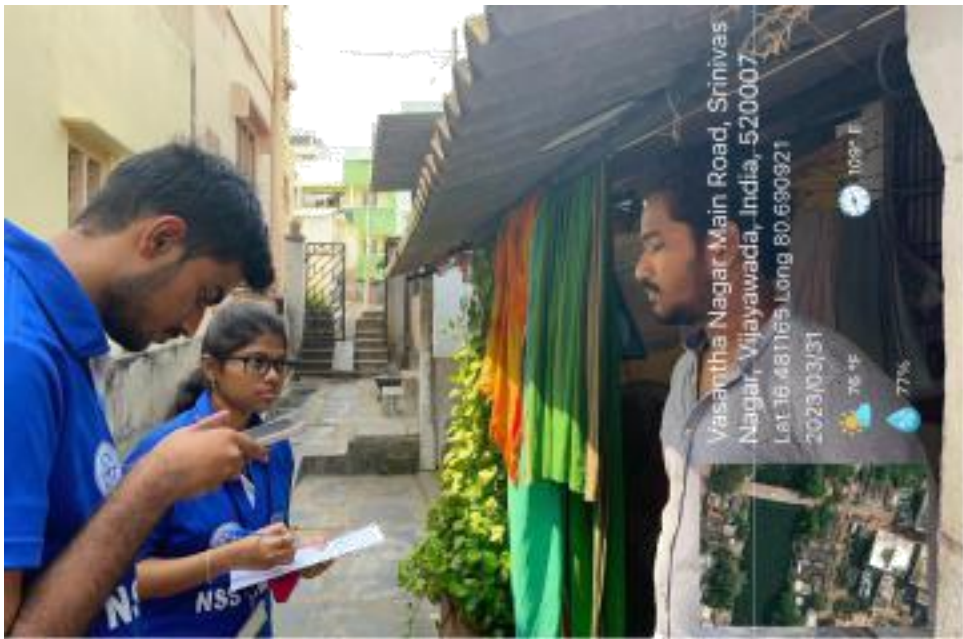
