1. LV Prasad Eye Institute Marathon

The LV Prasad Eye Institute (LVPEI) has organized a Marathon run on BRTS Road, Vijayawada on 01-06-2025 to raise awareness about retinoblastoma (eye cancer in children) and promote healthy lifestyles. The event has featured 3K, 5K, and 10K race categories, suitable for all age groups and fitness levels. 15 NSS Volunteers have rendered services and coordinated the event.



2. International Yoga Day

The International Day of Yoga is a day in recognition of Yoga that is celebrated around the world annually on 21 June following its adoption by the United Nations in 2014. Moreover, Yoga is important because it offers comprehensive well-being benefits for both mind and body, such as reducing stress, improving flexibility and strength, boosting concentration, and enhancing sleep quality. In this regard, 36 faculty members and 85 students have performed yogasanas under the able guidance of Mr. Murthy, Yoga trainer on 21-06-2025.



3. ISKCON Ratha Yathra

ISKCON-Vijayawada has organized a Jagannath Rath Yatra Mahotsavam in Kanuru on 05-07-2025, starting from the Sri Sai Geeta Mandiram, the procession proceeded through various roads in Kanuru before ending at the Sri Sai Baba Kalyana Mandapam, Vijayawada. 55 NSS Volunteers have rendered their services like pulling the chariot, clearing and controlling the traffic, distributing prasadam, etc during the yatra



4. Short Film Making – CYBER Frauds

The NSS Unit in collaboration with Krishna District Police Department has organized a Short Movie Making Competition on Cyber Frauds on 16-07-2025. 14 teams consisting of 67 students have registered and made 14 excellent movies which have been highly appreciated by the Police Department.



5. Seed Ball Preparation

500 Seed Balls are prepared by 48 NSS Volunteers on 18-07-2025 as seed balls are a vital, low-cost tool for environmental restoration and conservation, promoting reforestation and biodiversity. The balls have been disbursed in Kondapalli forest.



6. Awareness on Plastic Pollution

Plastic pollution is the accumulation of plastic objects and particles in the environment that harm wildlife, ecosystems, and human health. Hence, Awareness Drive on Plastic Pollution is conducted in Kanuru by 69 volunteers on 29-07-2025.



7. Awareness on Cyber Crimes

Awareness Drive on Cyber Crimes and Frauds is conducted by 62 volunteers in Kanuru on 30-07-2025 as cybercrime is an illegal activity committed by using a computer or network, while cyber fraud focuses on financial deception. Both can involve unauthorized access, theft, and trickery, but cyber fraud specifically aims to illegally acquire money or sensitive financial information through deceptive online means.



8. Literacy Awareness

Literacy awareness involves recognizing the importance of reading, writing, and other communication skills for individual empowerment and societal progress. It includes understanding that literacy is a fundamental human right and a key component of sustainable development. Hence, Literacy Awareness Drive is conducted by 58 volunteers in Kanuru on 31-07-2025.



9. Lunch at Orphanage

Lunch is offered to the 43 inmates of Sharon Orphanage, Mangalagiri on 03-08-2025. Funds are collected from the staff and students and 7 volunteers have coordinated the event.

NSS Orientation is conducted for I B.Tech students on 12-08-2025 by the NSS Team. The various events organized during the previous years are informed to the freshers.



11. Avishkandhra-2025

AVISHKANDHRA-2025 is an innovation and entrepreneurship mission in Andhra Pradesh, launched on 20-08-2025, with the theme "One Family, One Entrepreneur". The initiative is supported by the Ratan Tata Innovation Hub (RTIH) and aims to foster self-reliance by encouraging families to become entrepreneurs. 247 students have virtually attended the inauguration of the event. 19. Swachhathon 2025

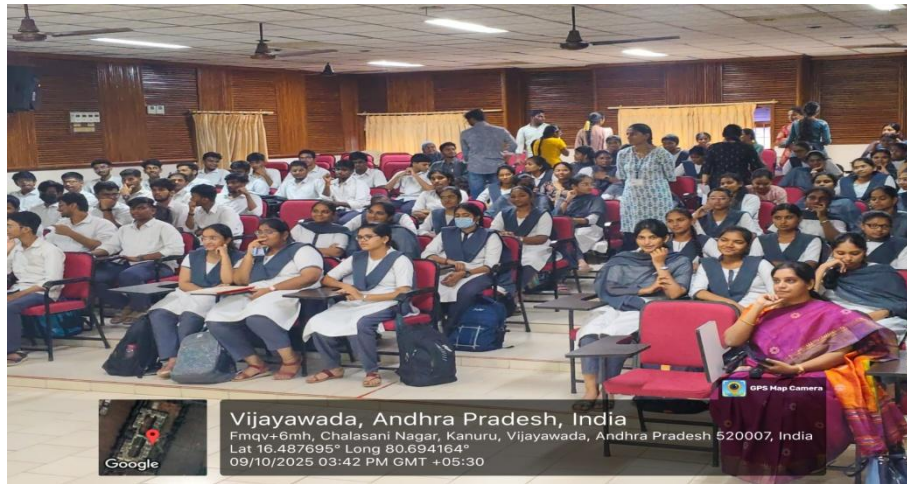

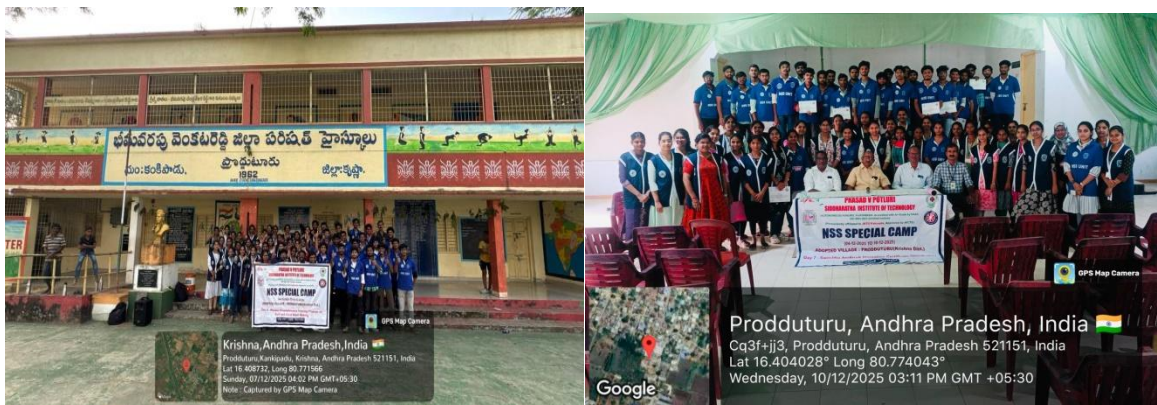
25. Blood Grouping Camp

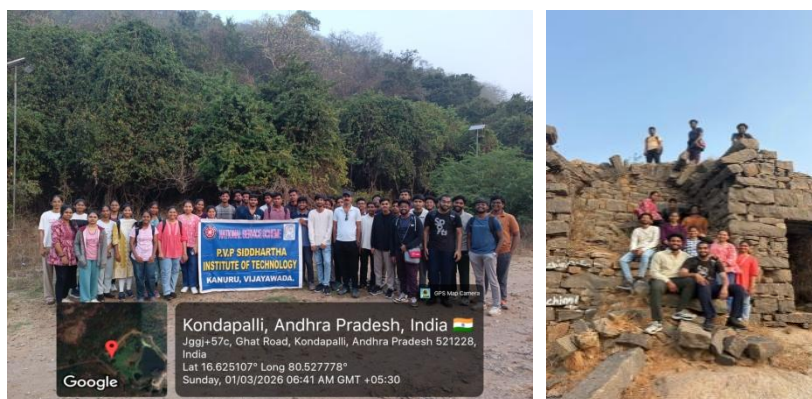
36. Rubik's Cube

4 volunteers have acted as mentors during ATL Boot Camp at Balliparru, Nidamanuru, during 11-13 March 2026.



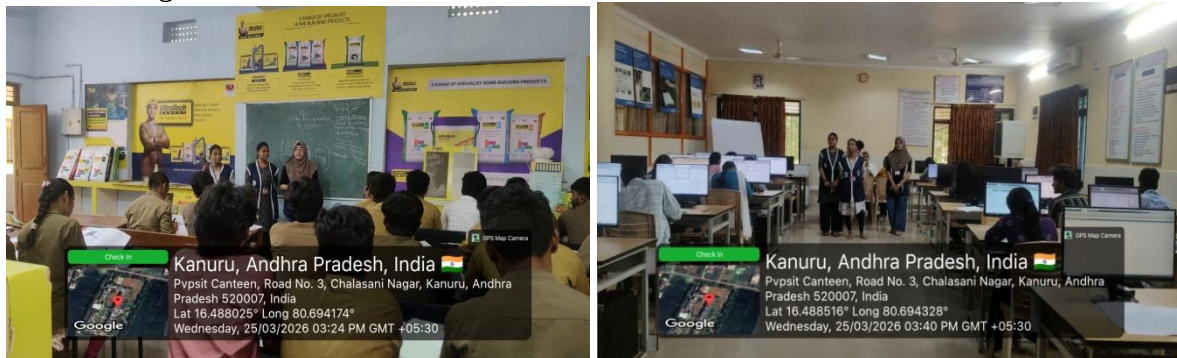
44. Cloth Donation
